	 They think God is a wrathful, vengeful God.
	• They think God doesn't care about sin.
	The truth is: God's wrath is His consistent and decisive opposition to sin and evil.
	A. Sin is pervasive. (8:6; 9:5c)
	B. Sin is unnatural. (8:7)
	C. Sin is based on lies. (8:9, 9:3-6)
	D. Sin is shameless. (8:12)
	E. Sin is destined for punishment. (8:13-17, 9:7-16)

	The truth is: God's <i>agape</i> love means His will is to our good for His glory and will fiercely do what He must to promote both.
