John 9

“Where are my blind spots?” 1 John 2:9-11

- A. He was Found by Jesus (vv. 35-36)
  - B. He Sees the Son (v. 37)
  - C. He Believes and Worships Jesus as Lord (v. 38)

Notice what the man calls Jesus throughout the chapter: “Jesus,” then “Prophet,” then “One from God,” and finally “Lord!”
